Over the break, our Softball Program hosted their Youth Clinic. Thank you to Angela Ganote for interviewing our athletes and Coach Miller to promote this annual event!

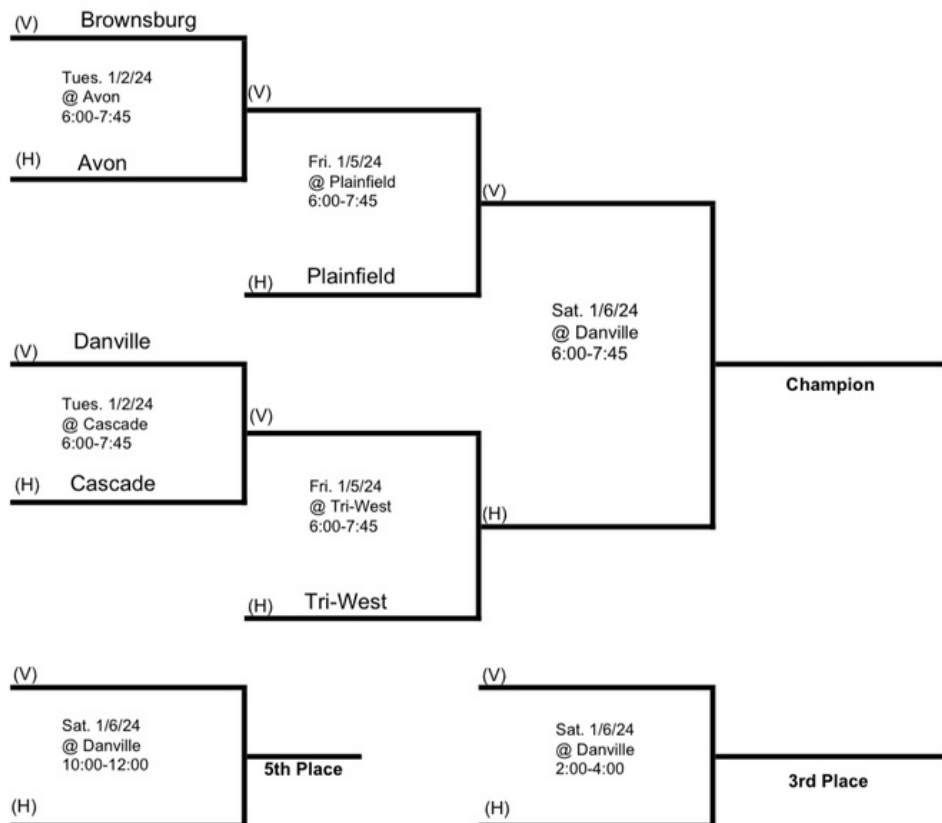


# HENDRICKS COUNTY BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT
