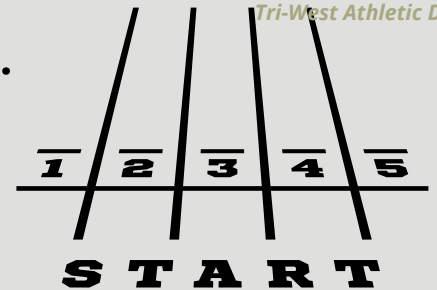
## MESSAGE FROM THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

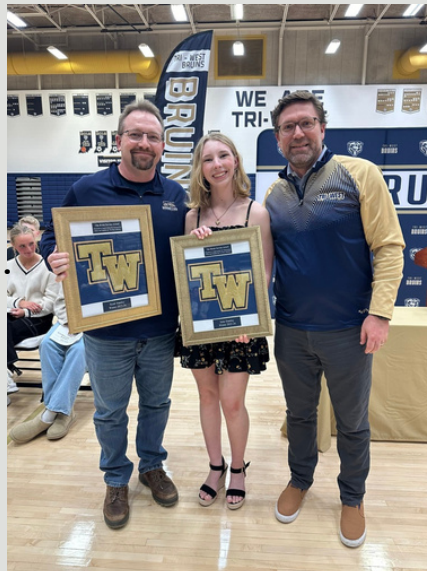

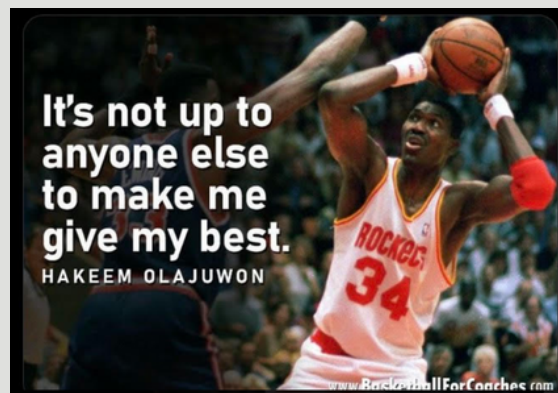
