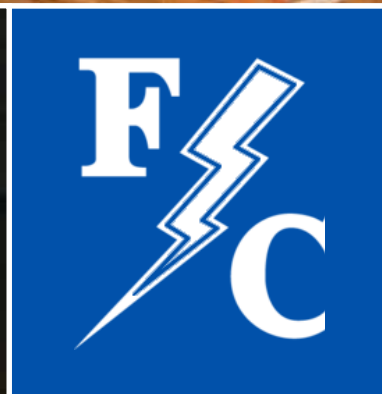

WHAT WILL YOU MISS MOST ABOUT FCVB?

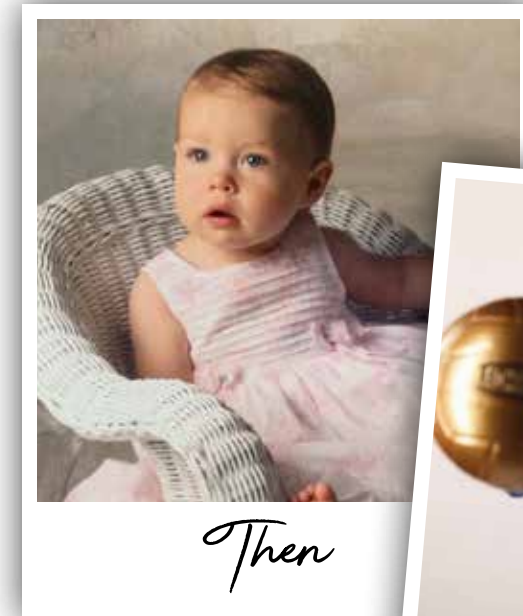
The coaching staff and all my friends I have made throughout the years.

WHAT WILL YOU MISS MOST ABOUT FCVB?

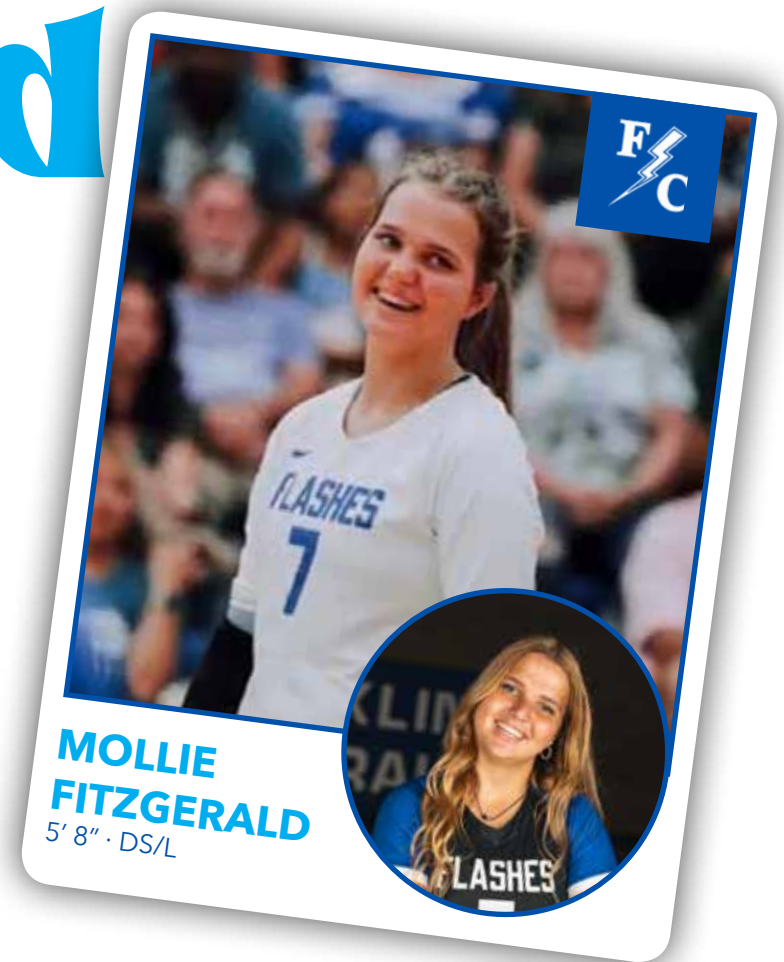
My best friends that I've made along the way and all the laughs during practice.

All of the friendships I have made with the girls over the years, I love y'all.

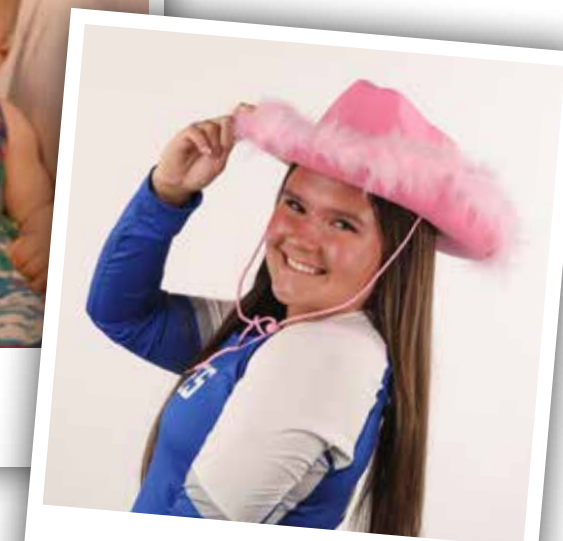
THANK YOU(S)

Finishing 9th at state with the mens' team.

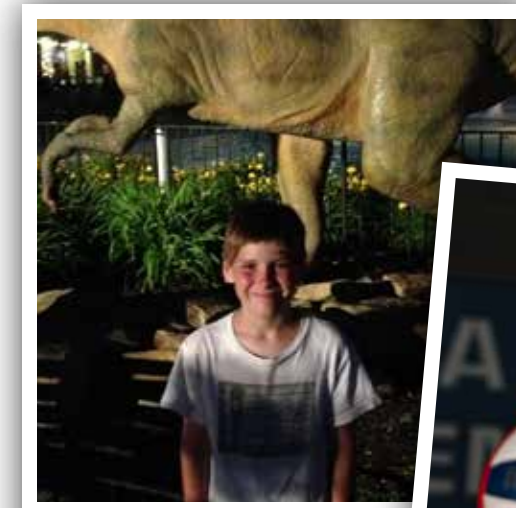
