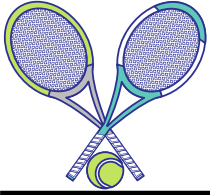
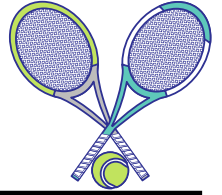

Adyn Davidson



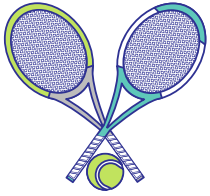

Cameron Evans

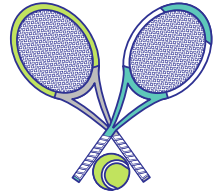

Hayden Hege



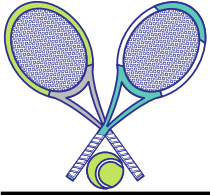

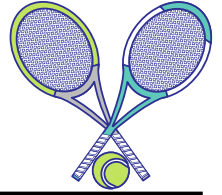

Chase Rigler



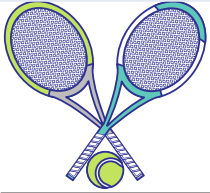

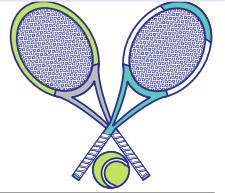
