Things you need to know prior to trying out.

- Our home golf course is Brookshire Golf Club in Carmel.
- You must be registered and have a physical (ALL 5 PAGES OF IHSAA FORMS) uploaded within that registration prior to any participation. See back of page for information on Registration and Physicals.
- Try outs begin on Monday, March 20th.
 - o Transportation to the course will be provided. You will need to have your equipment here at school so you can go directly from school to the course. We will leave school right after the buses leave. Families will need to drop you off on those days and equipment will be stored in a room downstairs near the junior high locker rooms.
 - The first two days are meant for golf talent evaluation; you will be putting, working on your short game, and hitting shots on the range. Cuts could be made prior to the 9-hole round(s).
 - We will then play at least one 9-hole round of golf, hopefully more if the weather allows.
 - The team will be selected prior to spring break, including a parent meeting for those who make the team.
- You will need to have your own set of golf clubs. If you are riding from school to practice, you will need to bring your clubs in the morning. We have a room for storage.
- Prior experience playing the game of golf is certainly advantageous but not necessary.
- We will keep a maximum of 10 golfers for the team.

Expectations

- You are representing Riverside Junior High and negative conduct will not be tolerated. The use of abusive language and/or damaging the golf course may result in immediate dismissal from try-outs.
- Please thank the Brookshire staff daily; it's a privilege to use the course for practice and play; they will only have positive things to say about us if we show our appreciation.
- Please dress for the weather. You need to be prepared for all kinds of weather, including gear for wet conditions (umbrella and a towel at the least). I don't mind if you wear jeans during try-outs, but a collared shirt is expected; no t-shirts.




Registration Process:
