<u>Physical and Registration</u> – All paperwork must be turned in before try-outs start. No Physical means no try-out. Registration and IHSAA physical form pgs. 3 and 5 need to be uploaded. If you played a Fall and/or Winter sport THIS school year, you are already registered/have physical forms in, so you are good to go! https://home.eventlink.com/

Eligibility - Refer to student handbook. We do not tolerate D's or F's. If that is an issue, please see me.

<u>Dress</u> - Golf course appropriate (no athletic shorts), nice shorts or nice pants/joggers, collared shirt, shirts tucked in. <u>Dress for the weather</u>!

<u>Clubs</u> - You must have your own clubs; school does not furnish them. You will receive a team bag to use during the season, but it will be returned at the end of the season.

Fees – Estimated Cost for playing golf at **RJH** is \$110.00 per player. This includes a \$15 fee to help offset costs associated with range balls/course usage and the rest will be for team attire...usually a polo or two, or a polo and a pullover and possibly an accessory depending on costs.

Behavior in School – Please do not be a problem in the classroom. Teachers will tell us when you are acting up. If you are a constant problem...you will be removed from the team.

<u>Behavior at the course</u> - Any behavior that will get you removed from the course will also get you removed from the team (especially during try-outs, positive attitudes will be expected). This is one of the fastest ways to get cut!!

TRY-OUTS

March 13-15, 2024.

If weather is an issue, we will try to get them done the following week. (I know this is Camp T Week for the 7^{h} Graders so we will do the best we can for the days they are at school).

Tryouts will last approximately 3 days and will consist of skills tests the first 2 Days and possibly some time on the course on Day 3 (depending on the weather).

** If we have large numbers trying out, we will make a first cut after Day 2, meaning not everyone will play on the course for tryouts.

Playing on the school team is a privilege. The expectation is that if you make the team, this is your first priority. If you have to miss practice or matches for other sports or clubs, there will be consequences.
