SETTING THE SCENE

- The Dragons and Tigers play their annual mid-January contest. This is the 47th meeting between the schools, with the Dragons holding a 27-19 lead in the series. NP has won two of the last three meetings.
- Tonight opens a four-game homestand for the Dragons to open 2024.
- Last year, the Dragons dropped a 58-46 decision at TC.

DRAGONS NOTES

- The Dragons opened 2024 with a 57-49 loss at Bloomington North Thursday. Senior Allie Blum scored 19 points and classmate Vivian Miller added 13. Blum and sophomore Natalie Sevier both had six rebounds. Blum added five steals.
- Sophomore Kenna Tweedy followed up her 10-point performance against Franklin County with eight points against Bloomington North, hitting two 3-pointers. Tweedy scored eight fourth-quarter points for the Dragons in the Dec. 28 victory over Franklin County, including the go-ahead 3-pointer.
- In the Dec. 28 victory over Franklin County, the Dragons outscored the Wildcats 30-15 in the final quarter and a half to turn a 10-point deficit into a 52-47 victory. Tweedy scored eight points in the fourth quarter, **Sadey Hughbanks** had a big game-tying 3-pointer earlier in the fourth, while Blum scored 19 points and Miller 15. Hughbanks grabbed six rebounds in the contest.
- Blum has scored 66 points in her last three games an average of 22.0 ppg including 19 each in the Dragons' last two contests. She also had 28 points against Southport. She has also led the Dragons in assists in those three contests. She hit 600 career points in last week's game at Bloomington North.
- The Dragons have won four of their last five games on their home court.
- Miller leads the HHC in assists, dishing 3.8 per game. Blum is seventh at 2.3 assists per contest.
- Blum ranks third in the HHC in scoring at 18.2 ppg. Miller is 10th at 11.0 ppg.
- Blum also ranks third in the conference in steals at 3.9 per contest. Miller is tied for eighth (2.5 spg).

SCOUTING THE TIGERS

- TC is 14-3 after winning the Shelby County Tournament last weekend with a 53-43 victory over Waldron and a 52-22 victory over Morristown. The Tigers have won thre straight and 12 of their last 13 after dropping two of their first three.
- NP is one of three 4A schools on TC's schedule the Tigers lost to Roncalli 58-23 in the opener. They play Kokomo Thursday at home.
- TC is led by sophomore Maryrose Felling, who averages 18.2 points and 3.3 assists per game. Senior Brooklyn Bailey adds 13.0 points and 8.4 rebounds per contest.
- TC has already clinched a piece of the Indiana Crossroads Conference title.

LOOKING AHEAD

- The Dragons continue their four-game homestand Friday with the annual double-header with Pendleton Heights, with a 6 p.m. tipoff. The JVs will play Thursday at PH. A victory would pull the Dragons even with PH in the loss column in the HHC race
- Next week, the Dragons have a single game, Thursday at home against Waldron.
- The IHSAA sectional draw will be held Sunday, Jan. 21. The Dragons will compete in the sectional at Pendleton Heights this season.

RECORD SETTER

Senior Allie Blum tied the Dragons' record for points in a regulation game Nov. 16 at Warren Central. Blum scored 36 points in the contest, hitting 10-21 from the floor and 12-15 from the line. She was 4-9 from the 3-point line. She became the first Dragon to score 30 points in a game since Isabella Gizzi tallied 34 Dec. 30, 2022 against Roncalli.

WELCOME BACK

Senior Vivian Miller missed the first four games of the season due to a soccer injury, but returned and made a quick impact. She had eight rebounds and five assists in that game. Miller then scored her career high with 21 points and added six assists in the Nov. 25 loss to Whiteland.

COMEBACK FOR THE AGES

The Dragons trailed New Castle 40-34 with 40 seconds remaining, but rallied to win in regulation. In the final minute, Kenna Tweedy put back her own miss to cut the deficit to four. On the next New Castle possession, the Trojans missed a layup but regained possession on a tie-up on the rebound. However, Allie Blum stole the inbounds pass and was fouled. She hit both free throws to cut the deficit to two. In the final 10 seconds, Blum forced a steal and fed the ball to Kendra Moore, who hit Vivian Miller for a layup to tie the game. New Castle inbounded with five seconds left, but Blum again stole the ball in the backcourt, again feeding Moore, who hit Miller for the game-winning layup ahead of the buzzer. Blum had nine steals in the contest to lead the Dragons.

STRONG AT SOUTHPORT

The Dragons had a tremendous second half on both ends Dec. 21 in their 60-22 victory at Southport. The Dragons outscored the Cardinals 36-6 after halftime - setting season-bests in both categories - including a 26-5 third quarter. The 26 points scored in the third quarter tied a season-best, while the one point allowed in the fourth quarter also tied a season-best for points allowed in a quarter. The Dragons forced 24 turnovers and had 16 offensive boards. Senior quard Allie Blum scored 28 points, including 11-23 from the floor. As a team, the Dragons were 22-53 and had 25 more field goal attempts than Southport, thanks in part to 16 offensive boards. Sadey Hughbanks had nine rebounds and Blum eight.

The 38-point win margin was the largest since a 68-24 victory over New Castle Nov. 29, 2022. The 22 points allowed were the fewest since a 68-17 victory over Connersville Nov. 7, 2019.

AT THE RIGHT TIME

The Dragons got big contributions from sophomore Kenna Tweedy at key moments in their 52-47 victory over Franklin County Dec. 28. They trailed 32-22 in the third quarter, but began clawing back, tying the game early in the fourth on Sadey Hughbanks' 3-pointer out of the corner. After FC scored four straight, Tweedy hit a jumper to tie the game again. With the Dragons trailing, Tweedy drilled a 3-pointer at the top of the key to give the Dragons their first lead of the night at 48-46 in the final two minutes. She capped the game with two free throws for her second double-figure game of the year. Allie Blum scored 19 and Vivian Miller 15 in that contest. The Dragons outscored the Wildcats 30-15 in the final 12 minutes of the game.

SHARP SHOOTING

The Dragons shot a season-best 50% - 22-of-44 from the field - in the Dec. 5 victory over Shelbyville. The victory showed the Dragons' balance, as **Sadey Hughbanks** scored a career-high 17 points on 7-of-10 shooting. **Vivian Miller** and **Kylee Beranek** scored 10 each, with Beranek hitting 4-of-5 from the floor. **Kendra Moore** shot 3-of-5 and scored eight points. Miller also had a career-high eight assists in the contest.

DOMINATING THE GLASS

In the Dragons' 57-47 victory over Delta Dec. 2, both **Sadey Hughbanks** and **Natalie Ssevier** had double-digit rebounding games. Hughbanks had 11 boards and Sevier 10. Hughbanks also had 11 rebounds Nov. 21 against Delta.

The high rebounder for the season is **Kenna Tweedy**, who had 12 boards in the Nov. 8 win at Greenwood.

RIVALRY WIN

The Dragons defeated arch-rival Mt. Vernon for the first time since the 2020 sectional with a 41-33 victory Dec. 12. The Dragons had strong balance in the victory, with **Allie Blum** scoring 10 points and both **Vivian Miller** and **Sadey Hughbanks** scoring nine each. The Dragons hit 33% from deep, including 3-6 from Hughbanks. They were also a perfect 9-of-9 from the line.

MEET COACH MOORE

Craig Moore was named the 15th head coach in program history in April 2023. He had spent the previous season as the Dragons' junior varsity coach. Moore brings 16 years of coaching experience to the position. He has coached at New Palestine Junior High, as well as coaching junior high girls and boys at Morristown from 2012-21. Prior to that, he was an assistant coach to Scott McClelland at Morristown from 20007-10, and spent two seasons coaching junior high boys in Rushville under coach Kerry Brown.

Moore is a graduate of Rushville High School and the University of Indianapolis. He also holds a graduate degree from Indiana State University. Moore is an assistant principal at NPHS. He and wife Misty have two children. Their son Drake currently plays basketball at Oakland City University. Their daughter Kendra is a sophomore at NPHS and a member of the varsity basketball team.

Assistant coach Erin Amones is a longtime teacher in the Southern Hancock district who currently teaches special education at NPHS. JV coach Leah Seib was a standout player for New Palestine from 2015-19 and led the Dragons to a sectional title in 2018 and an HHC title in 2019. She played collegiately at Marian University.
