SETTING THE SCENE

- The Dragons enter the sectional semifinal round to face Anderson, with the winner meeting either Mt. Vernon or Pendleton Heights.
- Friday is the third all-time meeting between the Dragons and Indians, all taking place in the tourney. NP won 64-53 in the 2020 Richmond sectional final and 59-55 in the 2021 sectional opener at Muncie Central.
- The Dragons are 11-3 in sectional games in five seasons under Coach **Sarah Gizzi** and have advanced to the championship game in four of the five years.
- The Dragons are seeking their seventh sectional title. They have won championships in 1990, 1992, 1993, 2004, 2018 and 2020. Coach Gizzi played for the 1992 and 1993 teams and was the head coach of the 2018 and 2020 squads.
- This is the second straight year and the third time in five seasons the sectional will have been played at Mt. Vernon. It was originally supposed to be held at Pendleton Heights, but water damage at PH caused a change. PH will host the 2024 sectional.

DRAGONS NOTES

- The Dragons advanced with a dominant defensive effort in the opening and closing minutes against Richmond. The Dragons opened the game on a 12-1 run and didn't allow a field goal for the first seven minutes, then mirrored that in the fourth quarter with a 16-1 run that encompassed the final seven minutes to open up a 45-27 victory. **Isabella Gizzi** scored 21 points, hitting 10-of-10 from the line, and added eight rebounds. **Vivian Miller** added 10 points. **Sadey Hughbanks** contributed a career-high five rebounds, while **Tylar Whitaker** had four assists.
- Gizzi's eight-rebound performance gave her 505 for her career.
- Gizzi became New Palestine's basketball career scoring leader - encompassing boys and girls - during Wednesday's game, as she improved her total to 1,629 points, eclipsing the total of 1,612 held by her brother, Maximus Gizzi, since 2020. She also holds the NPHS girls single-season (545) and single-game (40 points, 2021-22 vs. Southport) scoring records.
- Gizzi's 21-point game against Richmond marked the 18th time she has reached the 20-point mark this season. It was also her 77th career double-figure game.
- A victory Friday would clinch an eighth consecutive winning season for the program, tying a record set from 1991-99.
- At 23.7 ppg, Gizzi led the HHC in scoring in the regular season. She was also seventh in steals (2.8). Miller finished second in the league with 2.7 assists per game.

SCOUTING THE FIELD

- Anderson is 8-14 under first-year head coach Joe Adams, who came to the Indians after three seasons at Franklin County. The Tribe has won two straight games, including a 63-52 victory over Muncie Central in Wednesday's sectional opener. Junior Jaelyn Starks leads Anderson, averaging 14.2 points per game. Behind her, the Indians have a lot of balance, as sophomore Kennedy Brown scores 7.9 points per game, junior Makhile McWilliams tallies 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game, while senior Zoe Allen scores 7.0 points per game.
- Among the potential championship-game opponents for Friday's winner, Pendleton Heights swept the Dragons in two games last season and won 57-35 on Jan. 13 in a game at PH. The Warfel sisters lead PH - sophomore Kaycie tallies 20.6 points and 4.2 rebounds per game, while senior Whitney adds 15.1 points and 5.8 rebounds.
- Mt. Vernon has won four straight meetings over the Dragons over the last three seasons, with the Dragons' last victory coming in the 2020 sectional. MV won a 54-28 decision over the Dragons Dec. 13. Junior Ellery Minch leads MV, scoring 16.5 points and grabbing 5.2 rebounds per game. Sophomore Kayonrae Kenny adds 8.4 points.

SERIES HISTORY

The Dragons have played Anderson twice, winning 64-53 in the 2020 Richmond sectional final and winning 59-55 in the 2021 Muncie Central sectional first round.

Against potential final opponents, the Dragons are 18-47 against Mt. Vernon, having dropped four straight meetings over the last three seasons. The Dragons' last win was a 41-32 victory Feb. 5, 2020 in the first round of the Richmond sectional.

The Dragons trail the series with Pendleton Heights 28-18. They have dropped three straight in the series, including a 57-35 loss this season. The last win was a 57-54 victory Jan. 14, 2021.

RECORD SETTER

Senior **Isabella Gizzi** became the Dragons' career scoring leader with a 23-point effort Tuesday, Nov. 15 at Franklin Central. Her 1,173rd point eclipsed the record set by her mother, Dragons coach **Sarah (Haynes) Gizzi** from 1990-94. Isabella is one of five players in school history to tally 1,000 career points. She scored 288 points as a freshman, 345 as a sophomore and 451 as a junior. She also broke the single-season scoring record of 468 points previously held by Coach Gizzi Jan. 21 against Southport. Isabella also holds the school single-game scoring record of 40 points, set Nov. 13, 2021 at Southport, eclipsing her mother's mark of 36 set Dec. 1, 1994 at Pendleton Heights.

Senior **Isabella Gizzi** scored 35 points in the Dec. 6 victory at Shelbyville, hitting 9-16 from the floor, 5-8 from 3-point range and 12-13 from the line. It was the second-most in her career. She has tallied 30-plus points two other times this season, scoring 34 against Roncalli on Dec. 30 on 10-23 from the floor and 11-14 from the line.

Earlier in the season, she scored 33 points in the Nov. 26 victory over Whiteland, hitting 11-19 from the field and 8-10 from the line in the 71-60 victory. Gizzi has seven career 30-point games. During the 2021-22 season, she tallied a school-record 40 Nov. 13 at Southport. She added 33 Nov. 27 at Whiteland and 31 Jan. 18 against Eastern Hancock. She also scored 31 points in the 2021 sectional against Anderson.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Junior **Allie Blum** tallied the Dragons' first double-double of the season Dec. 20 against Lawrence Central, when she scored 14 points and grabbed a career-high-tying 11 rebounds, a mark she set Nov. 23, 2021 at Rushville. It marked her first career double-double and the Dragons' first since **Isabella Gizzi** tallied 20 points and 10 rebounds Nov. 16, 2021 against Franklin Central. Gizzi has two career double-doubles, as she also had 10 points and 10 rebounds Dec. 10, 2019 against Shelbyville.

Blum also had a career-high 12 rebounds against Triton Central, scoring six points in that game.

The Dragons started the game on a 12-1 run, holding the Red Devils without a field goal for the first seven minutes and getting three 3-pointers from **Isabella Gizzi** as well as one by **Vivian Miller**. **Allie Blum** added a second-quarter triple as the Dragons scored their first 15 from behind the arc. In the fourth quarter, the Dragons finished the game on a 16-1 run to put away a 45-27 victory, with Richmond not scoring a field goal for the final seven minutes.

CLOSING IN

Head coach **Sarah Gizzi** is closing in on becoming the second coach in program history to win 100 career games. Current AD **Allen Cooper** led the Dragons to 228 wins from 1988-2005 - 60 of which Gizzi was a player for from 1990-94. Gizzi is the second-winningest coach in the program's 49-season history, with Ernie Brewer (1983-88)'s 56 wins ranking third.

IN THE LINEUP

Freshman center **Sadey Hughbanks** is the first freshman to start multiple games for the Dragons since **Isabella Gizzi** started as a freshman in 2019-20.

GOING OT

The Dragons' 67-59 overtime victory over Greensburg Jan. 24 was their first OT game since a 67-65 loss to Pendleton Heights Jan. 14, 2022, and their first win since a 64-55 victory over Southport Nov. 13, 2021. **Isabella Gizzi** scored all nine points in OT and 24 in the game.

Coach Gizzi is in her sixth season as the Dragons' head coach. She has led the Dragons to two sectional titles - their first since 2004 - and the school's first HHC title since 1994, her senior year as a player at NPHS. In 2018-19, she also led New Palestine to a record 21 wins, including a school-record 12-game winning streak. The 2020 sectional championship victory over Anderson made her the second-winningest coach in NPHS history. As Sarah Haynes, Coach Gizzi became New Palestine's only girls basketball Indiana All-Star in 1994. She graduated as New Palestine's career scoring leader with 1,172 points. She also had 680 career rebounds. She led the Dragons to two sectional titles and three conference titles during her playing career. Gizzi played collegiately at La Salle University in Philadelphia. Gizzi was named to the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame's Silver Anniversary Team for 2019. Gizzi taught math at New Palestine Junior High and was the district Teacher of the Year in 2017. She currently works in the corporation office. Prior to becoming the varsity head coach, she was an assistant on the Dragons' staff from 2010-12 and coached the eighth grade team from 2013-17. She lives in New Palestine with her husband, Mike, who is the NPHS junior varsity boys coach, and their three children.
