- Create the loudest and most positive atmosphere possible when attending interscholastic events while maintaining full support for your school and their student athletes.

Security: To ensure the safest and most secure atmosphere for our IHSAA events, tournament management will diligently maintain established security procedures and activities. This will require complete cooperation by all competing teams, contest officials and fans. Security will always have priority over convenience; therefore, all individuals are requested to promptly cooperate with event personnel in any manner. Your assistance will enable tournament staff to fulfill its responsibilities efficiently.
