## Mr. Jeff Beach:

Jeff Beach is being inducted to the Winamac Athletics Hall of Fame as a Track Coach at. Coach Beach was the head track coach at Winamac for 21 years. During those 21 years, he had 21 winning seasons, and 703 career wins. During those 21 seasons, Coach Beach had 7 undefeated regular seasons, 6 Conference Championships, and 5 Sectional Championships (5 straight 2013-2017); with 2013 being the schools first ever. He coached 13 of the 16 track school record holders. He coached 11 entries to the state finals, including the 2007 and fellow Hall of Famer and State Champion Shane Crawford in the 100m. He was also a 4 time IATCCC District Coach of the Year Nominee and a 6 time Conference Coach of the Year. While going into the Hall of Fame as a Track coach, Coach Beach was also the Warriors Head Basketball Coach for 6 years. During this time he was able to bring the Warriors a Conference Championship, Sectional Championship and was voted Coach of the Year in 19595-96. Jeff Beach is also a 1976 Winamac graduate who lettered 9 times and was named the Athlete of the Year in 1976.



## Mr. Tim Roth:

Tim Roth is being inducted to the Winamac Athletics Hall of Fame as a Football Coach. Coach Roth was the head football coach at Winamac for 36 years. He is the winningest football coach in the history of Winamac football with 243 career wins. He was able to win 11 conference championships, 7 sectionals, and 2 regional titles. During his time as head coach he was also able to coach 13 North All-Stars, and coached in the All- Star game twice; the first time in 1990-91 season as an assistant and then the 2012-13 season as the North Head Coach. He was also able to serve as President of the Indiana Football Coaches Association in 2005. Coach Roth was the Region 4 Coach of the Year 3 times and in 2014 was

he also coached middle school track and basketball and also high school wrestling; where he led the Warriors to the first undefeated regular season in school history. Coach Roth earned multiple coach of the year awards not only in football but also in wrestling. Tim Roth is also a 1972 Winamac graduate who lettered 8 times while playing football, basketball and baseball.
